ABSENTEE BALLOTS AVAILABLE FOR BOCES CAPITAL PROJECT VOTE

Jan. 19, 2007 (New Hartford, N.Y.) – Residents in the 12 Oneida-Herkimer-Madison BOCES component districts who need absentee ballots for the \$38.55 million capital project vote on Feb. 13 can now apply for an absentee ballot.

Residents can contact the OHM BOCES district clerk's office at 315.793.8558. All absentee ballots must be returned to the district clerk's office by 5 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 13.

Voting will take place from noon to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 13. Residents can vote in each of their school districts at the locations that are normally used for school budget and school board elections.

To be eligible to vote, residents must be a U.S. citizen, at least 18 years old and a resident of one of the BOCES' 12 component districts for at least 30 days prior to Feb. 13. Voters **do not** need to be registered to vote, but will be asked to show a photo I.D.

The OHM BOCES serves the following 12 component school districts: Brookfield, Clinton, Holland Patent, New Hartford, New York Mills, Oriskany, Remsen, Sauquoit Valley, Utica, Waterville, Westmoreland and Whitesboro.
