Why Teach with iPods?

- 1 Engage students and get them excited about learning.
- 2 Enhance reading comprehension by combining visual reinforcement with audio information, which is particularly helpful for English Language Learners.
- 3 Accomodate multiple learning styles of students.
- 4 Limit outside distractions and help students focus.
- 5 Take videos anywhere. Portability enables teachers to use them to plan their curriculum at home. Students can use them to access videos when they have missed school or are homebound, and to reinforce concepts learned in the class.



We recently purchased streaming rights 100 middle school science videos and 50 elementary science videos for use with iTunes and iPods. This technology provides clear, sharp video in a small file size, ready for immediate use (no re-formatting required). Each title includes a full show, 7-10 content clips that can be integrated into lesson plans, and a teacher's guide, featuring assessment tests, lab activities, and a video script. All videos are accompanied by metadata. Keywords enable users to quickly and comprehensively search video clips.
