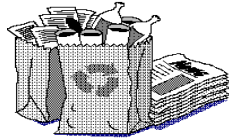


## Arbor & Earth Day

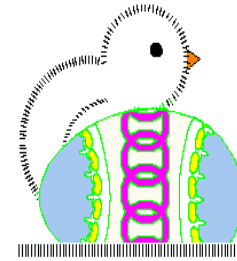
