Web/MAX - Did You Know?

- You many use first initial, last name as your user number.
- We give everyone the password, media. You may change this when you are logged into Web/MAX if you prefer.
- All curriculum resources are available to you in ONE place, our online catalog, Web/MAX. This includes digital sound, digital media, DVDs, kits, books, multiple book copies, videos, sheet music, and audio books on cassette and CD.
- You may search, browse and book media when you are in the catalog.
- You may print your searches and confirmations.
- You may check to see what you have ordered by going to ON Order, located to the left of the search page.
- You may also cancel or extend items (as long as they are NOT overdue or being called back).
- If you have not used Web/MAX in the past two weeks, give it a try. We have over 100,000 curriculum resources for you to use Pre-K through Grade 12 in a variety of formats.
- We provide training. Call Sylvia, 793-8513, to request training for your school. We provide training for EdVideo Online, the digital media content brought to you by WCNY and the public television stations of NYS.
- We provide training for Soundzabound, digital sound available in Web/MAX. You may download music to use in PowerPoint lessons, cultural activities, morning announcements, game shows, video storytelling, etc.
- There is no charge to a participating district for these training opportunities.
- You are welcome to come to our library and browse, take out materials, plan curriculum projects, etc. We welcome teachers to see for themselves the wealth of curricula-based media we have to offer. Many schools send their new teachers for orientation. Please call to set up a library visit for your school.
- There is a new Primary Literacy Catalog for K-3 available. Please call or email Sylvia for a copy. We have more than doubled the titles available in non-fiction-Social Studies, Science and Math based leveled readers.
- Teachers are encouraged to suggest titles for multiple book copy purchases. We have more than 900 titles in multiple copies. This is thanks to the many teachers who have asked for book purchases. We also are happy to purchase recommended video and DVDs. Please email or call with your suggestions for purchase.
