Soundzabound

We offer royalty-free music to all our participating schools. You access this special service through Web/MAX, our online catalog. All you have to do is click on DS (digital sound) and type in Soundzabound in the search box labeled publisher and the 319 different music selections will load for you.

There are many examples of ethnic music, try Irish Washerwoman for St. Patrick's Day - DS4893 or The Garry Owen Jig, DS4865. You can search using the publisher's search box (Soundzabound) the subject, St. Patrick's Day or the "search entire entry" box for Irish or the "title" box for Washerwoman. There are many options for searching. Just click on the icon and play the music.

To save music to a file or to your computer (so you can insert it into Powerpoint or play music from your computer) just right click and select Save as Target and save it where you want to keep it. I have purchased the rights for you to save the music and use it "in perpetuity." The rights are not going away so do not be afraid that all your work will have to be erased.

Soundzabound is perfect for student newscasts, game show productions, video storytelling, morning announcements and background enhancement to your lessons. Establish a student music file for the students to use in their work. There are many possibilities for use. We will set up workshops for teachers on how to integrate the music into lessons and how to set up files. Please call if you want a work session at your school.

We plan on working with Soundzabound to add more music every year as it becomes available. Try a little music in your classroom whether it is Mozart, Jazz, TV/Movie, suspense or a little Rock. There is a large assortment of sound effects, transitional, background enhancement music and cultural music (ethnic).
