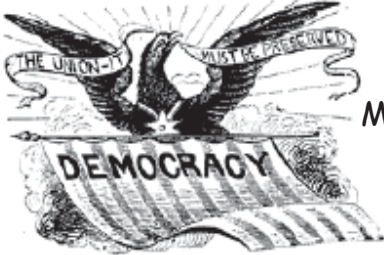

Copyright Responsibilities for Educators

Music - What can you copy?

You may make an "emergency" copy of music for an immediate performance only if replacement copies are on order. We will order additional copies of the music if you request them. The BOCES cooperative sheet music library purchases choral music, 50 or more copies at a time. If you require more copies please indicate the amount needed. We will always try to honor music requests. *Books* - You cannot copy an entire book. You may copy one chapter of a book. We buy multiple copies of books. When you request a book title, please indicate the number of copies needed. We usually buy 30 copies but honor requests for larger amounts 75-100.

Always Available - What does that mean?

When you see this in the annotation it means that we have a license to make as many as we need. It is always available. You may request this media for an extended period of time instead of the usual 5 instructional days. PBS titles from the Master Tape library also carry the "always available" designation. You may request these for as long as you want. However, you need to call the Media Technology office so that we may book these items for you.
