However, the content has changed from United Streaming™ to Power Media Plus™. The new service allows teachers and students access from school or home and includes over 300 PBS programs. All WebMAX users in our database have an account to access the EdVideo content. The titles are in our WebMAX online catalog and are labeled, EdVideo Online. You only need the one log-in and you can access all our curriculum materials and the EdVideo content in one place. Our own digital content will also be searchable through Power Media Plus™. Login to WebMAX as usual and select DM as your format and browse. The EdVideo icon takes you right to the Power Media Plus™ website. We are also providing the training for the EdVideo Online's Power Media Plus™ content. The training dates are listed in this newsletter. This is introductory training.
