- ✦ Streaming and uploading local content including Regent's Review Live!
- ✦ Links to additional resources, teacher's guides, interactive Web sites, etc.
- ✦ Ability to stream locally produced content

All of the above services are copyright compliant and supported by a robust database, catalogued for easy retrieval and stored on local servers.

### New Science Digital Media

Be sure to visit Web/MAX to check out all the new Bill Nye and Biomedial digital media (DM) just added to our catalog.

-To search for the Bill Nye titles put Bill Nye in the "Search in Title" box, check the "DM" box in the Media Type, and click the "Items Aquired After 12 Apr 07" box - this will bring up our 64 **NEW Bill Nye** Digital Media titles. For each title there is also a resource guide and teachers guide.

-To search for the BioMedia titles put Biomedial in the "Search By Producer" box, check the "DM" box in the Media Type, and lick the "Items Aquired After 12 Apr 07" box. This will bring up 359 **NEW BioMeida** titles along with their teachers guides and image banks.
