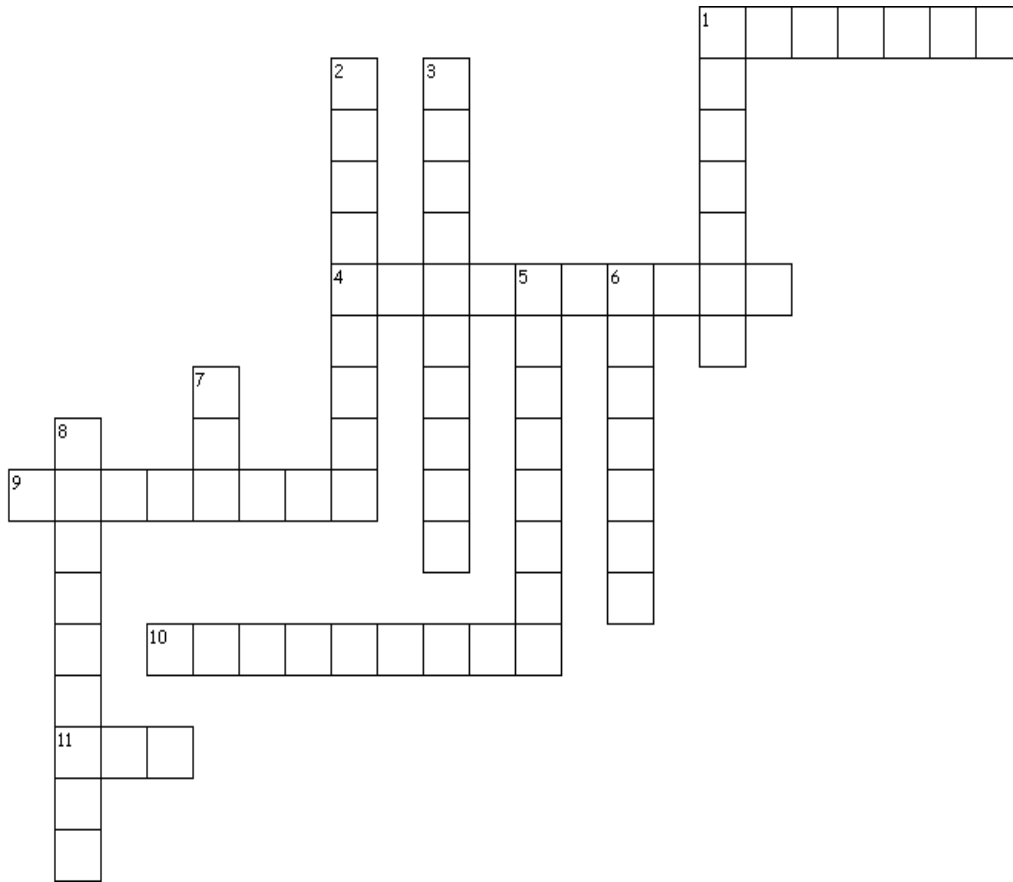


Weather Crossword
