- 1) **Welcome** and overview of the day.
- 2) **Pat Lekki – LAS Services** – demonstrated various reports on Mandarin. She also showed where help sheets for Mandarin and Follett could be found on their web page The reports she demonstrated included:
  - a) Deleting items and printing a report with scannable barcodes for SLS
  - b) New easy label creator for Mandarin
  - c) ILL Report that should be run for SLS
  - d) Compare report
  - e) ItemList – shelf
  - f) Item State
  - g) Inventory Reports
- 3) **John Gummoe – World Book** update and demo – John demonstrated the World Book Digital Library which is an enhanced digital book. Their reference books are being converted to digital books but they have added activities so they are more than a standard eBook. There is a translation component and a “read aloud toolbar.” Pat Skelly will talk pricing with John to see if these products can be included in the SLS Virtual Reference Library CoSer. John also talked about World Book Advanced and the feature that has it linked to public domain eBooks.
- 4) **John Palaszynski- CMA Demo** – John provided a demonstration of the webcams and software that SLS is planning to use for training on the new CIDER software. The new software is almost through the approval process so Pat wants the technology in place to do intensive training when it is unveiled. Librarians will receive a camera and use one of the licenses from BOCES to join in the virtual trainings. This will allow more timely trainings and save travel time. LMSs will be able to use this technology for other trainings as well.
- 5) **SLS and Media Updates** – Sylvia Sallustio joined the meeting. She hopes to be back at work in June.
  - a) Make sure requests are in for Multiple Books and Music Requests
  - b) Fill out the annual survey for SLS
  - c) Summer trainings will be out soon. The Toni Buzzeo workshop is July 23, 24 and is being designed especially for us. It is just for librarians and teachers working in libraries. It is to learn the new AASL standards inside and out. Pat encouraged everyone to sign up!
  - d) There will be two workshops this summer run in collaboration with the public library systems
    - i) One on book repair from Kapco (back by popular demand)
    - ii) One on making books for curriculum projects and special events with Bertha Rogers (also back by popular demand)
