Prevention is the key, but we will be addressing specific, common repairs: tipping in loose pages, broken spines, torn header caps, ripped and torn pages. Each participant is asked to bring:

- **two paperback books**, preferably new or new-like, to demonstrate covering techniques
- **a hardbound book with a book jacket** to demonstrate application of book jacket covers
- **a stapled book or magazine**
- **a book that needs to have a loose page tipped in**
- **one hardbound book** that needs repair
- **pair of scissors**

Each participant will be provided with a *free* sample packet of materials.
