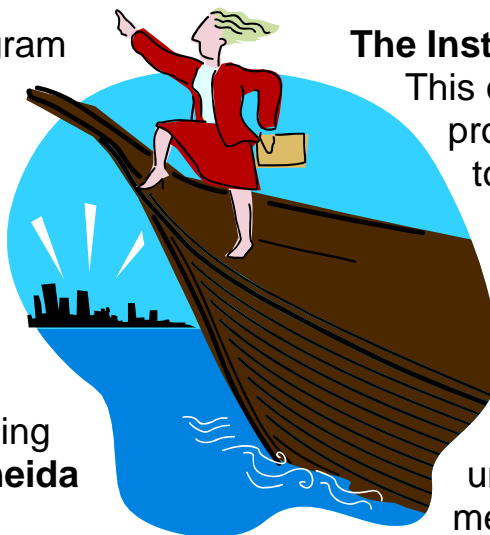




# Reading and the Secondary SLMS
