For instance, you want to demonstrate how to search for a book in your catalog: you work through the steps on the computer talking as you go and Jing records. Participants should bring lesson content that they wish to use in their recordings; they can access web-based programs from the BOCES training lab, but check with us prior to class regarding specific software programs you use in your classroom. Teach students to create their own Podcasts and Jing videos for class assignments. **We will be working on PCs not Macs.**
