This is a tremendously fun read aloud, especially if you can manage a good ‘old man’ voice when you shake your fist!

The non fiction title is also a lovely book. Pastel drawings and short narrative descriptions take you through many migrating animals.

I use this as a research starter. Students can choose a migrating animal and do research about habitats and reasons for migrating. (see separate doc - migration)

Migration is discussed in listening and learning domain 8 animals and habitats for grade 1.
