Chameleon is sad because he does not have a color of his own. He goes from place to place and changes colors. He thinks if he stays on the leaf forever, he will have a color but then the leaf changes color. He makes a friend and they decide to stay together so that they will always be the same.

Camouflage and Disguise is another very short, simple book that has nice photographs of some unusual animals in their environments.

I think this would make a nice paired activity. You could have each student draw and color a chameleon. They could trade papers with a partner and the partner could draw an appropriate background for the chameleon to blend in with. (ex. if the chameleon was green, the partner could draw a leaf, if it is brown, the partner could draw draw tree bark.
