Mechanics of Rating

- Use only *red* ink or *red* pencil to score student responses. Do *not* attempt to *correct* student work by making insertions or changes of any kind.
- Use check marks in the boxes to the left of each question number on each student answer sheet to indicate incorrect or omitted answers in Parts 2 and 3. Do *not* place a check mark beside a correct answer.
- Record the Credit Earned for Parts 1-4 in the appropriate box at the top each student answer sheet.
- Add the Credit Earned for Parts 1-4 together to indicate the Total Credit Earned and record it at the top of the student answer sheet.
- The rater responsible for scoring and/or calculating the score for each part must initial the appropriate box as well.
- Check carefully for mechanical errors (e.g., addition). Using a calculator might be helpful.
