Mechanics of Rating

- Use only *red* ink or *red* pencil to score student responses. Do *not* attempt to *correct* student work by inserting corrections or changes of any kind.
- Use check marks in the boxes to the left of each question number on each student answer sheet to indicate incorrect or omitted answers in Parts 2 and 3. Do *not* mark the bubbles on the *Student Answer Sheet*.
- Record the Credit Earned for Parts 1-4 in the appropriate box at the top each *Student Answer Sheet*.
- Add the 'Credit Earned' for Parts 1-4 together to indicate the 'Total Credit Earned' and record it at the top of the *Student Answer Sheet*.
